

Colorado Council Of Camera Clubs

2008 Information Sheet for Club Representatives

Each member club is entitled to two representatives who:

- Attend the quarterly Council meetings,
- Submit the club's slide and print entries,
- Take turns judging the entries.
- Report on Council activities and competition results to their club,
- Vote on behalf of their club on Council business—elections, bylaws, etc.

Meetings

The meetings are held at the convenience of the host club or on the last Thursday of February, May, August and November at the Epiphany Lutheran Church, 790 South Corona St. The meeting starts at the host club's convenience or at 7:30 PM. All competition entries should be submitted at least 15 minutes before the start of the meeting.

Competition Entries

Each club may enter 12 projected images and 12 prints in each quarterly competition. Images which have won an award in a previous Council monthly or, now, quarterly competition or year-end competition are not eligible even if entered in a different category or through a different club. The subject matter of the competitions is Open.

A club with more than 20 members as of March 1 of the competition year may not submit more than two entries by any individual and each of these two entries must be in a different category (color print, monochrome print, slide or digital projection). A club with 20 or fewer members as of March 1 of the competition year has no restrictions on the number of entries from any individual member.

A list of each club's quarterly entries will be transmitted, using the form on the Council's website, at least 48 hours before the start of the competition.

Prints may be color or monochrome in any combination. Color prints will be judged separately from monochrome prints.

Prints must be mounted or matted. The minimum mount or mat (not image) size is 11x14 inches and the maximum size is 16x20 inches. Mounts cannot be Masonite or other heavy material having sharp corners or edges. Prints must be unframed and must not have any hanging devices attached to the back. All prints must have a Council print sticker in the upper left corner of the back with the maker's name, print title, and club name filled out.

Slides must be in 2x2 inch mounts, which are thin enough to drop from an 80-slide tray. The slides must be spotted in the lower left corner when viewed normally and have the maker's name and title written on the mount.

Images for digital projection must have a vertical dimension no larger than 768 pixels and a horizontal dimension no larger than 1024 pixels. The images must be in JPG format in sRGB color space with a file size no larger than 500 KB. Images not meeting these requirements may be rejected.

Judging

A panel of 3 judges and 1 alternate, no two of which are from the same club, will be selected. The judges will vote on each entry on a scale of 1 to 5. A judge will vote 0 on entries from his or her club and on any other entry where he or she knows who the maker is. If a judge votes a zero, the scores of the other 3 judges will be totaled. If all judges vote then the score of the

alternate will not be counted and the scores of the other 3 judges will be totaled. Ties will be broken by a second or third vote.

Awards

The points awarded on the first score will be accumulated throughout the year for the year-end awards.

Programs

A club wishing to present a program may submit a request to the Council Board at a Board Meeting prior to the Business Meeting at which the club wishes to present the program.
